Legislative Update

Representative Bill Dean and Representative Jennifer Gross introduced [HB 371](#) – Issue 1 Implementation Act – in the Ohio House late last year. HB 371 would require all changes to Ohio law that result from the passage of Issue 1 last November go through the legislature, rather than the Ohio courts. HB 371 has been assigned to the House Civil Justice Committee.

Representative Gross looks forward to providing updates on her legislation as the Ohio General Assembly continues to meet!
