USS Cincinnati Cold War Memorial and Peace Pavilion Unveiling



Representative Jennifer Gross attended the unveiling of the USS Cincinnati Cold War Memorial and Peace Pavilion at the Voice of America Museum Center in West Chester. Representative Gross enjoyed learning about the history of the USS Cincinnati and meeting those who served America on this submarine.

The USS Cincinnati was a Cold-War attack submarine. The submarine was launched in 1977, commissioned in 1978, and decommissioned in 1996. The picture above is of veterans who served on the USS Cincinnati that attended the unveiling. Parts from the original submarine will be used to build a replica for a proposed Cold War Memorial and Peace Pavilion at Voice of America MetroPark in West Chester. Construction of this project is expected to take 10 months and start in the summer.

Gross said, "I was honored to meet those who served on the USS Cincinnati. Thank you to those who are working to bring the USS Cincinnati to West Chester and to educate people on the rich history of Southwest Ohio."

Alpek Polyester Visit



Representative Gross was delighted to tour the Alpek Polyester manufacturing facility located in West Chester. Alpek Polyester produces polyester sheets from recycled bottles to provide packaging for produce, bakery items, pre-packaged food, and other consumer goods.
